C M FOR STUDENTS	What characteristics do you mostly see in the God of the Old Testament? Why? What about the New Testament?
CHALLENGE	Pastor Clayton talked about taking next steps in our faith. Is there a step that you feel God has been placing on your heart but you haven't done anything about yet? What is it and what can you do this week to take a step of faith?
SCRIPTURE	<ul> <li>Hebrews 13:8-10 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings. It is good for our hearts to be strengthened by grace, not by eating ceremonial foods, which is of no benefit to those who do so. We have an altar from which those who minister at the tabernacle have no right to eat.</li> </ul>
