SERIES & TITLE	<i>Book of Hebrews: Something Better - Week 8</i>
 BIG IDEA	You cannot understand the Bible, and you cannot understand God, without understanding the concept of sacrifice.
 ICE BREAKER	This year's Easter offering is going to Mobilize - an initiative to care for and support schools in need around our communities. How do you plan to get involved and sacrifice? Check out CentralAZ.com/mobilize for more info.
 DISCUSS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. How would you define “Sacrifice?”2. When have you sacrificed for someone else? Is it still a sacrifice if it costs you nothing?3. How does the Day of Atonement practiced in the Old Testament parallel Jesus' act on the cross?4. How has God sacrificed for you and all of mankind?5. Share when you decided to be baptized and why. If you haven't been baptized - why not?
 FOR STUDENTS	Pastor Cal shared that we live in a "me first" culture. How is that different from the culture Jesus creates?
 CHALLENGE	Spend some time every day this week reading Hebrews. Pray before you read, asking God to open your heart to hear what He has to say to you. After reading the scripture, spend 10-15 minutes seeking to hear from God. Write down what you feel God is speaking to you.
 SCRIPTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!● Hebrews 9:15 For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance—now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.
 PRAYER	Take some time and pray for those that got baptized this past Sunday - that God would be with them, protect them and bring them community as they start this journey following Jesus.
