 <p><b>BIG IDEA</b></p>	<p>For discipline to be of benefit, you must receive it with a heart of submission.</p>
 <p><b>ICE BREAKER</b></p>	<p>How did your parents discipline you?</p>
 <p><b>DISCUSS</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What was your view or understanding of discipline before Cal's sermon?</li><li>2. Spend time discussing the questions Cal asked at the end of the sermon:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Are you giving your best to God?</li><li>○ What would need to change for you to do so?</li><li>○ What difficulty in your life might God be using right now to create a harvest of righteousness in you?</li></ul></li><li>3. How can God's discipline bring healing and growth into your life?</li></ol>
 <p><b>FOR STUDENTS</b></p>	<p>What is something you want to be more disciplined in?</p>
 <p><b>CHALLENGE</b></p>	<p>Is there an area in your life God has disciplined you in? See it as his love for you.</p>
 <p><b>SCRIPTURE</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Hebrews 12:1-3 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.</li><li>● Hebrews 12:7-11 Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as his children. For what children are not disciplined by their father? If you are not disciplined—and everyone undergoes discipline—then you are not legitimate, not true sons and daughters at all. Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of spirits and live! They disciplined us for a little while as they thought best; but God disciplines us for our good, in order that we may share in his holiness. No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but</li></ul>

painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace
