ICE BREAKER	Shan shared the story of finding his first job. What was yours and how'd you get that job?
MAIN POINTS	 Jesus Cares About Your Everyday Problems God doesn't just want to be your "911 call" - He wants to be invited into the details of your life There's no part of your life too small to invite Jesus into Jesus Works Miracles Through Obedience seen in Mary's powerful instruction to the servants: "Do whatever He tells you" Jesus Saves the Best for Last: The world gives you its best upfront, then it fades - Jesus does the opposite.
DISCUSS	 Shan mentioned that "every miracle begins with a problem." What problems in your life right now could use Jesus' attention? How does it change your perspective to know that Jesus cares about the small, everyday details of your life? What areas of your life have you not invited Jesus into because you thought they were "too small" for God's concern? Mary told the servants, "Do whatever He tells you." What is Jesus currently asking you to do that might not make complete sense? Have you ever had a time when you had to obey God without fully understanding His plan. What was the result? Shan asked: "Does your obedience ever put you in a position of needing a miracle?" What does this question reveal about our lives? How can we live more boldly? Can you share about a quiet, personal miracle you've experienced recently? How can we train ourselves to better recognize God's voice and movement in our lives? Shan asked "What if my best is behind me?" How would you encourage someone struggling with this feeling? How would you answer: What if I've prayed and haven't received the miracle I want? How do we maintain faith during seasons of unanswered prayer?
NEXT STEP	What's one practical way you can include Jesus more in your ordinary moments this week?
SCRIPTURE	John 20:30-31 Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
