- Öʻ- BIG IDEA	All faith is fragile until it's been tested by fire. It is the fire that purifies.
ICE BREAKER	Pastor Cal shared some difficult news with the church this weekend. As we navigate this difficult news as a church and you engage with this as a group we want to encourage you to keep a few things in mind:  1. It's completely normal to have questions and for people to express their feelings but please avoid or allow assumptions, speculating or gossiping to occur in your group. How did you or are you working through this?</li> <li>What do you no longer believe about God or the Church that you once did?</li> <li>How can doubt and deconstruction strengthen our faith?</li> <li>Pastor Cal shared "Whenever we take our eyes off Jesus, and put them on anyone or anything else we are going to sink." How do we keep our eyes fixed on Jesus through the storms and difficulties of life?</li> </ol>

CHALLENGE	Pastor Cal shared three stages of growing in your faith: 1) Construction- building your belief system and worldview. 2) Deconstruction- challenging that world view and subsequent beliefs. 3) Reconstruction-rebuilding a new, more holistic set of beliefs and world view. Identify where you are at in your relationship with God and your faith.
