SERIES & TITLE	<i>Intervention: Discovering How Much God Loves You - Week 1: I Love You, But... Jan. 12-15</i>
 BIG IDEA	Love takes the risk.
 ICE BREAKER	Pastor Cal shared the story of getting a speeding ticket and that the worst thing someone can say to you is "I told you so..." What's the last "I told you so..." you experienced?
 DISCUSS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. What most stood out to you from the message this weekend? Why?2. From hearing the message, what is God conveying to us through the Book of Malachi?3. How do you respond when faced with an unwelcome truth?4. Has God been speaking to you a truth you may not want to hear?5. Read the Scriptures below. What does this tell us about genuine and pure relationships?
 FOR STUDENTS	Who are the people in your life that speak truth to you in love? Can you and do you also speak the truth, even when it's difficult?
 CHALLENGE	This week, take a risk and ask someone that you trust to share if they have any feedback on any area in your life. Just listen to what they say and say thank you for sharing. Then process what was said to you and ask God to show what changes you need to make.
 SCRIPTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Proverbs 27:6 Wounds from a friend can be trusted, but an enemy multiplies kisses.● Proverbs 17:17 A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of Adversity.● Proverbs 9:8-9 Do not rebuke mockers or they will hate you; rebuke the wise and they will love you. Instruct the wise and they will be wiser still; teach the righteous and they will add to their learning.
 PRAYER	Ask God to open your heart and mind over these next couple of weeks to ways in which He may want to intervene and show you something in your life.
