 <p>SERIES & TITLE</p>	LOVE BEYOND...This Present Moment
 <p>BIG IDEA</p>	The end of Jesus' ministry marked the beginning of ours.
 <p>ICE BREAKER</p>	What is one thing you feel a sense of urgency about in your life right now? Why does this make you feel urgent?
 <p>MAIN POINTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● The church's purpose is to make disciples - We were given one job by Jesus, which is to make disciples of all nations by baptizing and teaching. This requires us to love one another beyond any differences.● Now is the time for urgent action - Jesus could return any day, so we need to act with urgency to fulfill the mission he gave us. The signs he described indicate his return is drawing near.● Be aware, not afraid - While this should create urgency, it should not lead to fear. We need to be aware and focused on the mission.● Make every moment count - We don't know how much time we have left before Christ's return, so we need to make the most of each moment and be fully engaged in ministry.
 <p>DISCUSS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● What most stood out to you from your message this past weekend?● Why do you think Jesus made disciple-making the mission of the church? What does this require of us?● How can we balance urgency with living presently and not in fear? What practical steps can you take?● What are some ways you can be more focused on ministry and making disciples in this season? How can this group support you?
 <p>CHALLENGE</p>	Take a bulb and pray for the person that God laid on your heart each day.
 <p>SCRIPTURE</p>	Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky?
